26th Annual AYSO Beverly Hills Sportsmanship Cup



Team Invitation

Hello, Coaches! AYSO Region 76 is proud to invite your team to the 26th Annual AYSO Beverly Hills Sportsmanship Cup

Scope: AYSO Invitational – open to AYSO teams only from all Sections.

When: Saturday & Sunday, December 21 through December 22, 2024. Saturday & Sunday, January 4th

through January 5th, 2025, Tentative Rain Dates.

Where: The tournament will be held at Beverly Hills High School, Horace Mann School, El Rodeo School, Hawthorne

School, La Cienega Park, Roxbury Park, Fenton Field, Kenneth Hahn Park, Community Magnet Elementary School, Fairfax High School, Rancho Park, the Veterans Administration, LACES, and John Burroughs Middle

School, California. There is no charge for parking. No pets are allowed at school fields.

Who: AYSO boys and girls teams in age divisions: U-14 (11v11) 15 players max. U-12 (9v9) 12 players

max. and U-10 (7v7) 10 players max. All players must be registered and have played in the 2024 Fall AYSO primary season as a core or Extra team. If there are sufficient Extra teams in any division, there will be a special flight for those Extra teams; if there are not enough Extra teams in a particular division to form a separate flight, there will not be a special Extra flight in that division and Extra teams will be placed in the regular U10, U12, and U14 tournament divisions. Matchups take account of information about the team provided to the tournament scheduler. Guest players will be allowed (3 maximum per

team). Co-ed teams will be accepted in boys' divisions only.

What: Pool play tournament. Each team will be guaranteed 4 games in pool play. Referees award

sportsmanship points at each game based on the extent of compliance to AYSO philosophies by players, coaches, and spectators. The top teams in each boys and girls age division will be awarded a Sportsmanship Trophy and medals. All games will be as follows: (60 min. for U-14, 50 min for U-12,

and 40 min for U-10).

Why: The Beverly Hills Sportsmanship Cup is by Region 76 to raise funds for Field Development,

Equipment, & Maintenance, and to provide Scholarship funds for youths in Region 76 and neighboring

regions.

Awards: All players, coaches and referees will receive a tournament pin. 2 coaches per team and all referees

will receive a tournament t-shirt. All referees will receive one food and drink coupon per day. Players with the top sportsmanship point teams will receive medals and their team will receive a trophy. In addition, there may be trophies awarded for various defensive oriented standings such as "fewest goals against," details of

which will be provided to teams upon registration

Entry Fee, \$600 for U-14, \$550 for U-12, and \$500 for U-10. A full refund will be issued if tournament is canceled Refunds: for both the 12/21-12/22 2024 and 1/4-1/5, 2025 weekends, and cannot be rescheduled. If a team

If a team withdraws 30 or more days before the tournament, a full refund is granted within 72 hours of request and mailed as soon as possible. Within 30 days and 15 days of the tournament, no refund is provided unless a replacement team is found. Within 14 days of the tournament, no refund will be provided unless we determine that finding a replacement team will not be too disruptive from a scheduling,

financial, or organizational standpoint.

Referee Fee, \$400, refundable within 14 days of the tournament, if referee assignments have been completed. Each team is asked to provide a qualified 3-person referee team to cover 3 games during the tournament.

Partial refunds will be given based upon the number of game slots completed.

Rules: A full set of tournament rules are posted on the tournament website.

Acceptance: The application deadline is November 30, 2024. All teams will be notified within 48 hours of the

application deadline or receipt of application (whichever is latest) as to their status. Teams that are not accepted will be given the option to have their complete application returned or to be placed on the

waiting list.

How: Applications are accepted online at http://www.ayso76.org. All necessary forms and information are

available on the tournament website. After entering all information online, including tournament

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application, referee information, and team roster, teams should do one of the following: 1) send 1 Region check that covers both the Entry and Referee fees, and your Regional Commissioner-signed team roster to the address below OR 2) you can pay with a Team Diivy Card on a link on the tournament page on the Region 76 website for your division.
