

# MISCONDUCT SUMMARY



## MISCONDUCT

#### **CAUTION (YELLOW)**

- Unsporting behavior
- Dissent by word or action
- Persistently infringing the Laws of the Game
- Delays the restart of play
- Fails to respect the required distance on a corner kick, free kick or throw-in
- Enters/re-enters/leaves the field of play without permission

#### SENDING OFF (RED)

- 1. Serious foul play
- 2. Violent conduct
- 3. Spits at any person
- 4. Denies a goal or obvious goal-scoring opportunity by deliberately handling the ball (DOGSO)
- 5. Denies an obvious goal-scoring opportunity by an offense punishable by a Free Kick or Penalty Kick (DOGSO)
- 6. Offensive/insulting/abusive language or gestures
- 7. Receives a second caution in the same match



### MISCONDUCT

Misconduct is rare for players in 10U games.

Referees should deal with it by talking to the player's coach and without showing cards.



Coaches and spectators can be warned and even expelled from the game.

But they must <u>never</u> be shown the red or yellow card.

These are not common incidents in AYSO younger age games.

Ask coaches to deal with inappropriate spectators.
