Hello, Coaches!

AYSO Region 76 is proud to invite your team to the 27th Annual Michael Karlin AYSO Beverly Hills Sportsmanship Cup

Scope: AYSO Invitational – open to AYSO teams only from all Sections.

When: Saturday & Sunday, December 13 through December 14, 2025. Saturday & Sunday, January 3rd

through January 4th, 2026, Tentative Rain Dates.

Where: The tournament will be held at Beverly Hills High School, Horace Mann School, El Rodeo School, La

Cienega Park, Roxbury Park, Fenton Field, Kenneth Hahn Park, and others as appropriate. There is

no charge for parking. No pets are allowed at school fields.

Who: AYSO boys and girls teams in age divisions: U-14 (11v11) 22 players max. U-12 (9v9) 18 players

max. and U-10 (7v7) 14 players max. All players must be registered and have played in the 2024 Fall AYSO primary season as a core or Extra team. If there are sufficient Extra teams in any division, there will be a special flight for those Extra teams; if there are not enough Extra teams in a particular division to form a separate flight, there will not be a special Extra flight in that division and Extra teams

will be placed in the regular U10, U12, and U14 tournament divisions. Matchups take account of information about the team provided to the tournament scheduler. Guest players will be allowed (3

maximum per team). Co-ed teams will be accepted in boys' divisions only.

What: Pool play tournament. Each team will be guaranteed 4 games in pool play. Referees award

sportsmanship points at each game based on the extent of compliance to AYSO philosophies by players, coaches, and spectators. The top teams in each boys and girls age division will be awarded a Sportsmanship Trophy and medals. All games will be as follows: (60 min. for U-14, 50 min for U-12,

and 40 min for U-10).

Why: The Beverly Hills Sportsmanship Cup is held by Region 76 to promote good sportsmanship in AYSO

and to raise funds for Field Development, Equipment, & Maintenance, and to provide AYSO player

Scholarships.

Awards: All players, coaches and referees will receive a tournament pin. 2 coaches per team and all referees

will receive a tournament t-shirt. All referees will receive one food and drink coupon per day. Players

with the top sportsmanship point teams will receive medals.

Entry Fee, \$600 for U-14, \$550 for U-12, and \$500 for U-10. A full refund will be issued if tournament is canceled for both the 12/13-12/14, 2025 and 1/3-1/4, 2026 weekends, and cannot be rescheduled. If a team

If a team withdraws 30 or more days before the tournament, a full refund is granted within 72 hours of request and mailed as soon as possible. Within 30 days and within 15 days of the tournament, no refund is provided unless a replacement team is found. Within 14 days of the tournament, no refund will be provided unless we determine that finding a replacement team will not be too disruptive from a

scheduling, financial, or organizational standpoint.

Referee Fee, \$400, refundable within 14 days of the tournament, if referee assignments have been completed. Refunds: Each team is asked to provide a qualified 3-person referee team to cover 3 games during the

Rules: A full set of tournament rules are posted on the tournament website.

Acceptance: The application deadline is November 25, 2025. All teams will be notified within 48 hours of the

application deadline or receipt of application (whichever is latest) as to their status. Teams that are not accepted will be given the option to be placed on the waiting list. **Priority consideration will be**

given to teams that supply a full referee crew.
